ASHTRAY BY DJ SKIPPER

To become a coctail you MUST create a new flavour.

The Ashtray is a complete ritual for lovers.

The ritual starts with the bartender asking two lovers, a few questions.

- 1) "What do you like?" addressed to the lady.
- 2) She replies for instance "Gin". The bartender pour the gin into a mixer.
- 3) "What do you like?" addressed to the man
- 4) "I prefer whiskey". The bartender pours it into a mixer.
- 5) "What do you like?" addressed to the lady.
- 6) She replies i.e. "martini".
- 7) "What do you like?" addressed to the gentleman.
- 8) "Sherry". And the bartender pours it into a mixer.
- 9) "What do you like?"
- 10) Answer i.e. Pepsi Cola.
- 11) What do you like?
- 12) Answer i.e. Portwine
- 13) What do you like?
- 14) Answer i.e. White wine.
- 15) ... more possibilities such as tomato juice, vodka, Chatreuse, egg, liqueur, etc.

This ritual continues for a minute or two. And the guests starts laughing and being amuzed. This mix is the most unique coctail for those two persons ... their private coctail, so to speak.

Then the bartender pours the mix into an ashtray, preferably just one ashtray, which has the three openings for a cigaret.

The couple – probably much amuzed at this moment – then should drink/sip the coctail out of the holes. No need to say, that they are probably spilling, if not the first sip, then the next. The memory of cleaning the clothes together will become a laughter to all family members at the wedding, silver wedding, etc.

Do you remember, what we mixed the night we met?

DJ Skipper invented the basic concept in year 1980 at King Valdemar Hotel. The ritual was added at a later date. DJ Skipper has released the book "Between Caviar and Champagne", and worked in the sphere of major artists and their managements in the music & entertainment business.
